January	Board reviews 2022 library activities to determine if Goals and Objectives were met. Gather information and prepare an Annual Report for your library files and your council. Remember to report this to your council.  Each year, municipal libraries receive an email with a link to Municipal Affairs Public Library Services Branch (PLSB): at <a href="https://www.alberta.ca/public-library-board-operating-grants.aspx">https://www.alberta.ca/public-library-board-operating-grants.aspx</a> you will find the following:  • Application for Financial Assistance for Municipal Libraries  • Statement of Receipts and Disbursements (audit) forms  • Budget forms  • Annual Report of Public Libraries in Alberta forms  Fill out and submit information to Municipal Affairs Public Library Services Branch in order to receive your annual operating grants.		
	Please send a copy of the Annual Report, Statement of Receipts and Disbursements, and current year's budget to Marigold headquarters.		
February	<b>Invoices go to municipalities</b> for Marigold Levy. (Schedule C requisition) – 1 <sup>st</sup> of February.		
	<b>Board</b> ensures council provides sufficient funding so library is eligible for provincial operating grant.		
	<b>Board</b> gathers 2022 financial records for audit or financial review in January or February.  Survey and Annual Report deadline for online submission to Municipal Affairs Public Library  Services Branch is February 28 (Submitted via LibPas). Send a copy to Marigold headquarters.		
	Community Library Annual Reports due to Marigold in mid-February.		
April	Marigold sends first installment of <b>Services Grant</b> to local board or Community Library Society before the end of April.		
May	Annual Marigold Library System Conference – May 10, 2023 for library staff and board.		
June	Marigold sends community library grants to library service points (community libraries) before the end of June.  June 15 is the final deadline for submission of all parts of the grant application package. Libraries must submit to Municipal Affairs Public Library Services Branch at libgrants@gov.ab.ca  • 1 copy of Application for Financial Assistance for Municipal Libraries  • 1 copy of Annual Report  • 1 copy of audited Statement of Receipts and Disbursements*  • 1 copy of Budget  Send a copy of the Annual Report, Statement of Receipts and Disbursements, and Budget to Marigold headquarters.  * Note: Be sure to include any money that you receive from your municipality in support of utilities, insurance, janitorial services, etc.  Submit changes or established policies and bylaws to PLSB at <a href="libpolicies@gov.ab.ca">libpolicies@gov.ab.ca</a> and to Marigold Headquarters.		
August	Find out when your council wants budget estimates.  Marigold sends second installment of the <b>Services Grant</b> to local board or Community Library Society.  Invoices go to Local Library Boards for Marigold levy (Schedule C requisition)		
November	Detailed operating <b>Budget</b> estimate for 2023 sent by library boards to Marigold Headquarters. If you haven't already presented the budget to council, do so now.  Marigold sends final installment of <b>Services Grant</b> to local board or Community Library Society.
